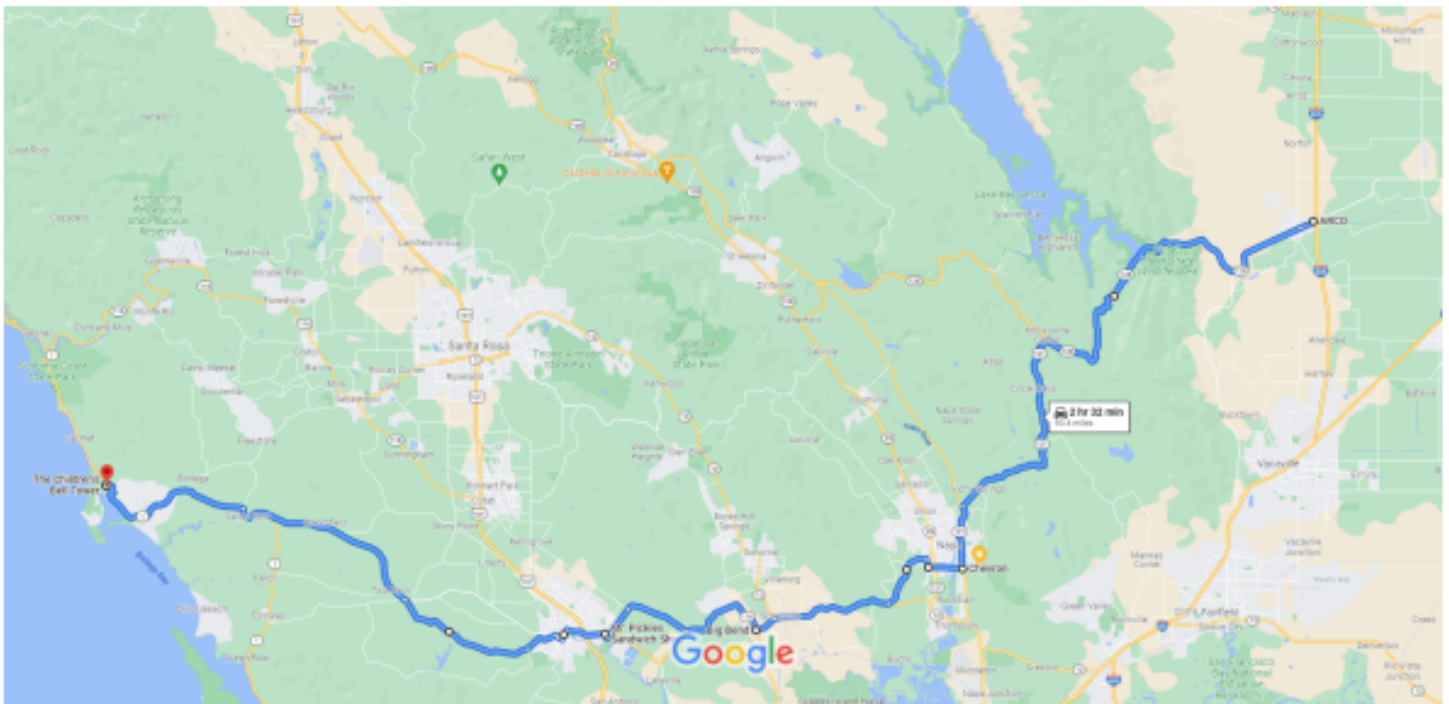


BODEGA BAY – CHILDREN’S BELL TOWER RUN

October 18-19, 2021

A little history of the tower:

Plaque Inscription: The **Children's Bell Tower** is dedicated to children everywhere, but is a memorial inspired by the death of seven-year old **Nicholas Green** of Bodega Bay who was shot by highway robbers while vacationing with his parents in Italy, on September 29, 1994. It is a 18' tall, 140-bell tower with **Nicholas**, and the seven recipients inscribed on the 30" bell in the middle. The family donated his organs to Italians waiting for transplants, which sparked a surge in Italians and others signing donor cards.

Start: AM/PM Gas Station, 701 Matsumoto Lane, Winters

Total mileage: 90.4 miles (2 hours 32 minutes not including stops/traffic)

1	0	0	Turn right onto CA-128 West
2		21.2	Stay left at CA-121 South towards Napa
3		12.6	Continue on CA-121 South to Silverado Trail
4	33.8	33.8	Turn left onto Silverado Trail (CA-121)
5		2.7	Stay left at Soscal Avenue
6	3.3	37.1	Go 0.6 miles to Chevron Station (bio break)
7		--	Turn right onto West Imola Avenue
8		1.8	Turn right onto Foster Road
9		0.4	Turn left onto Old Sonoma Road
10	5.5	41.9	Turn right onto CA-12 towards Sonoma
11	7.1	49	Continue on CA-12/W 7.1 miles to CA-116 W (Arnold Drive)
12		--	Arnold Drive becomes Stage Gulch Road
13		--	State Gulch Road becomes Old Adobe Road
14		--	Old Adobe Road becomes Frates Road
15		9.7	Frates Road becomes Cader Lane at Lakeville Highway
16		0.5	Turn right on South McDowell Boulevard
17	10.4	59.4	Turn right to Dandy Sandos Sandwiches, Petaluma
18		0.1	Turn left onto Lakeville Hwy
19	1.9	61.3	Turn left onto East D Street
20		0.5	Turn right onto 6th Street, which changes to Howard Street
21		0.4	Turn left onto Western Avenue, which changes to Spring Hill Road
22	9.7	7.1	Turn left onto Bodega Avenue which changes to Valley Ford Road and then CA-1 North
23	19.4	90.4	The first left after the Mexican restaurant is the Community Center. The Children's Bell Tower is at the rear.
